We request:

1. the responsible persons get rid of all kinds of violence by any group, and seek peaceful resolution.
2. foreigners withdraw all kinds of violence and weapons from Syria.

How to participate?

Anybody can join at any place. Basic style is :

1. Describe your thoughts for Syria by writing, drawing, singing, etc.
2. Let us strike a pose, for instance, standing up, jumping, etc.

Then, we take photos or movies (maximum 1 min.) to report your actions.

Finally, please report your action via email or FAX. Please do not forget to write the number of participants in your action. The deadline is in March 30, 2013.

Public gatherings bang spoons on metal plates to illustrate furious weapons. Church groups and temples arrange the bells to be rung at the same time in cities across the country to seek peace.
